ISBIS-2010 will provide a varied and stimulating scientific program of invited and contributed papers, and excellent opportunities for formal and informal exchanges. Authors will have the opportunity to submit extended versions of their papers for publication in a special edition of the Society's journal, Applied Stochastic Models in Business and Industry (ASMBI) after the conference.

The conference will also feature an ASMBI Invited Discussion paper, which is now a tradition of ISBIS conferences.

Themes

The scientific program will have four main themes:

- Statistical Image Analysis what is it, and why is it relevant?
 The conference will open with an introduction to Image Analysis by Jean Serra, co-founder of the area with Georges Matheron, and continue with several sessions exploring industrial applications and associated theory
- Large and Complex Data Sets what's happening, and where are things going? At ISBIS-2008 in Prague, July 2008, we had a session exploring how software developers were responding to the needs of the massive-data-analyst--in-the-street
- Statistics in Financial Services how are things changing, in areas such as Modelling and Managing Portfolio Credit Risk, Structure Models Pricing and Asset-Liability Modelling? The recent financial crisis has strongly affected the banking and insurance industry and possible analytical consequences thereof will be examined
- Quality in Health Services what are the opportunities to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of health services? The systematic application of Statistical Quality Control tools is progressing at a different speed in many countries and participants will have the opportunity to share their experiences in this area
