## **Guidelines for Manuscript Preparation**

Abstract up to 300 words is required through http://www.action-m.com/ok2011/submission.php.

After the abstract acceptance, the authors are advised to use the official template in MS Word format to prepare the full paper. The best way to meet the format requirements is to copy and paste your paper into the template file. You will find the template on the web site of the conference.

Some points that need to be considered while preparing the paper:

- paper length: 2-4 pages including figures, tables & references
- paper size: only PDF format A4 (210mm X 297mm) is accepted for the paper submission
- PDF requirements: Please DO NOT apply security settings to your PDF file, DO NOT number pages of your paper, LEAVE EMPTY the header of your paper
- language: The only accepted language of the paper is English
